TYPES OF DONATION CARDS

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WHAT ARE THE COMPONENTS OF EFFECTIVE DONATION CARDS?

No matter what cause you're fundraising for or which demographic you're appealing to, ensure you include these key elements in your donation card template:

- Information about your nonprofit and the purpose of the card
- Appeals and calls to action specific to the purpose of the card
- A QR code or direct link to your giving page (for eCards)
- A return envelope to send payment information back to the nonprofit (for physical cards)
- A photo featuring your beneficiaries
- Specific instructions for how to donate
- Thanks for their support
- Your nonprofit's brand components, like your logo and color scheme

While creating your card, aim to make it as user-friendly and visually appealing as possible. Not only will a streamlined card design facilitate the donation process, but it will also come across as professional and boost the chances of retaining the recipient as a recurring donor.



DONATION CARD TEMPLATES

Before we get into the front part of a donation card, let's discuss the standard appearance of the back of the card that recipients can send back to make a gift. It should have these basic information fields:

- Donor information, such as name, address, phone number, and email
- Preferred contact method
- Donation amount checkbox or blank space
- Payment information, with options for check and credit card
- Signature field

Each donation card will vary depending on the nonprofit and its needs, so ensure you're asking for the most relevant information. Now, let's take a look at our templates for all types of donation cards so you can start to tailor your own:





GENERAL DONATION CARD TEMPLATE

Key takeaway from this donation card template:

When you aren't marketing a specific cause, it's even more important to evoke your mission and demonstrate the impact of a donation in tangible terms. Ensure you use numbers to highlight the real effects of contributing so donors understand how their gift will be used.





EVENT-SPECIFIC DONATION CARD TEMPLATE

[Front of the card]

- Organization's logo
- A compelling image that represents the event, such as a ballroom for a gala
- Your event's branding [if applicable]

Heading: [Write a catchy tagline that's relevant to the event]

Key takeaway from this donation card template:

This donation card functions partially as an event invitation and partially as a RSVP card. Tailor your own donation card to reflect the event's formality and theme. For instance, if you're sending a donation card for a casual potluck, you can have a more laid-back tone of voice, whereas you should maintain a formal approach for black-tie events.



CAMPAIGN-SPECIFIC DONATION CARD TEMPLATE

- Organization's logo
- A compelling image that represents the campaign
- Your campaign's branding [if applicable]

Heading: Stand With Us To [achieve campaign goal]

Body: Dear [**recipient name**],

Key takeaway from this donation card template:

By using phrases like "stand with us," this donation card humanizes the nonprofit professionals on the other side of the card and makes the appeal feel more personal. Using inspiring language in this card helps the donor feel empowered to contribute to the larger goal. Also, by providing a suggested donation amount, the card facilitates the decision-making process for the recipient.

- A compelling image that's relevant to your nonprofit's mission or the recurring giving program
- Your recurring giving program's branding [if applicable]

Heading: Become a [recurring giving program participant] today!

Key takeaway from this donation card template:

Since this card is being sent to an existing donor, it's crucial to highlight the impact of their previous contributions and how they can magnify their impact. Also, ensure you highlight the unique benefits of joining the recurring giving community to further entice the donor to join. This card should feel like an invitation to join an impactful inner circle, which makes the donor feel special.



MATCHING GIFT DONATION CARD TEMPLATE

- Organization's logo
- A compelling image that's relevant to your nonprofit's mission or campaign

Heading: Supercharge Your Impact With Matching Gifts

Key takeaway from this donation card template:

This card is different from the others because it's more focused on generating awareness of corporate responsibility programs than it is on promoting a specific cause. However, the end result is the same: yielding more donations for the nonprofit. Key takeaway from this donation card template:

Planned giving and estate planning are delicate topics, so your donation card should treat them with respect. Don't mention death verbatim, and instead, focus on the recipient's ability to make a lasting impact on your beneficiaries. Staying optimistic is crucial, no matter what appeal you're making, but especially when planned giving is involved.
